As a result, the MAB did not grant an extension of accreditation validity until December 31, 2025, and instead recommended initiating a new accreditation procedure.

Formulation of the objective:

Preparation of the self-evaluation documentation and all required annexes for the accreditation, including all necessary resolutions, declarations, and agreements. Submission of the complete accreditation material to the MAB. The quality objective is the successful completion of the accreditation process, which has also been approved by the Senate of the University of Pécs.
