

## **Krisztina Szabadfi Talent Management Programme Publication Scholarship Call for Application**

University of Pécs, Faculty of Sciences - according to the paragraph 25th (3) of the Code of Charge and Benefits, which is Appendix No. 6 to the Organisational and Operational Regulations of the University of Pécs - announces Publication Scholarship under the Krisztina Szabadfi Talent Management Programme to support student publication activities.

The application is available for students studying at a BSc, undivided, MSc or PhD programme, who possess an active student status in the 2024/25 spring semester.

This Publication Scholarship is a one-time benefit, provided for one semester, the lowest sum of which cannot be less than 20% of the student normative sum valid at the time of award, which is 33,320 Forints. Concerning this, maximum 45 students may receive the scholarship.

Students can apply with only **one** publication, the approval of which is not older than 5 years and the publication must match one of the following conditions:

- a) peer-reviewed journal article or
- b) patent, registered with registration number or
- c) peer-reviewed book, or chapter of a book.

Applying with a publication submitted earlier to and assessed within Krisztina Szabadfi Talent Management Programme is invalid.

Multiple publications can be submitted to the application, but the Assessment Committee will evaluate only that one, which has been submitted the latest.

Compulsory documents for the application:

- Application formula (*every applicant shall receive it via e-mail*)
- Publication(s) considered as subject of application, in pdf format. If the work has not been published yet, a certificate of acceptance must be attached (e.g.: editorial confirmation e-mail). In the case of registered patent, its registration number must be provided. If the publication is a peer-reviewed book, or chapter of a book, then ISBN or ISSN number must be provided by the applicant.

**Submission deadline: 2<sup>nd</sup> of April 2025 12:00 CET (noon)**

Applications shall be submitted electronically, via: <https://www.ttk.pte.hu/en/publication-scholarship>

After submitting the application electronically, the applicant shall receive the complete application sheet (based on the uploaded documents) via the e-mail address they provided earlier. The printed and signed application sheet shall be brought to Office A223 on the Dean's hallway to Dr. Emese Tékus.

**Applications received after the deadline are not accepted by the Assessment Committee. Complementing documentation and finalizing the application is not possible after the deadline.**

Deadline of the decision about submitted applications: 17<sup>th</sup> of April 2025.

Applications will be evaluated on the basis of appendix 1 by an Assessment Committee of 3 people nominated by the Dean. The ranking list's first 45 students shall receive the scholarship. Applicants shall be notified until the 25<sup>th</sup> of April 2025 via the e-mail address provided in their Neptun account.

Deadline of the scholarship distribution is: 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2025

The student shall have the right to appeal against the decision. The appeal addressed to the Secondary Educational Committee shall be submitted to the primary decision maker body immediately upon the arrival of the official decision, or maximum 15 days after the student gets to know about the results. The submission of this appeal must include the attachment of the supporting documents necessary for the review.
